

What is Kiva?

Kiva is an international nonprofit, founded in 2005 and based in San Francisco, with a mission to connect people through lending to alleviate poverty. We celebrate and support people looking to create a better future for themselves, their families and their communities.

Where Kiva works

Kiva serves borrowers in more than 80 countries on 5 continents. Field Partners and Trustees on the ground help connect with borrowers. Field partners screen borrowers, post loan requests to Kiva for funding, disburse loans on the ground and collect payments.

How does it work?

- 1. A borrower applies for a loan
- 2. The loan goes through the underwriting and approval process
- 3. The loan is posted to Kiva for lenders to support
- 4. Lenders crowdfund the loan in increments of \$25US or more until the full amount of the loan is achieved
- 5. Borrower receives the loan and begins to repay the loan over time
- 6. Lenders use repayments to fund new loans

Kiva lenders crowdfund on average of \$2.5 million in loans each week, creating a unique, renewable pool of funds that is reshaping access to financial services around the world.



Appleby's history with Kiva

October 2008

Kiva was introduced by Global Outreach and the plate was passed to fund an initial donation from the Appleby Congregation and we were off and running with five loans of \$50 US each.

Additional contributions over the past 9 years has brought the total deposits from the Congregation to \$1,019.
