

Advertisement - Director of Music

The people of Appleby United Church located in Burlington, Ontario are seeking a creative and technically competent person to assume choral and keyboard leadership for their faith family, and who can or is willing to learn to provide similar leadership for handbells and Djembe drums. The congregation is established and seeking to grow. The sanctuary has a well-maintained Allen Renaissance Organ model R270B manufactured August 2, 2002 (2-manuals) with a full pedal board which has numerous possibilities (i.e. Baroque, Werckmeister and Romantic registrations), and a Pramberger grand piano. The parlour also has a Kawai upright piano. The Adult Choir (singing weekly), the Small Group Choir (singing occasionally), the 3-octave Handbell Choir (playing occasionally) and the Djembe Drumming Group would require four rehearsals a week and one Sunday service, in addition to weekly meetings with clergy leaders and monthly with the Worship Committee. It is estimated that this part-time position will demand about 20 hours a week. The appointee will be expected to meet annually with representatives of the Church Council to evaluate past achievements, and explore a vision for the future. Some funding may be available for continuing education upon approval, vacation is provided and a benefits package is optional. Remuneration will be in the range of the RCCO guide. Applications (which will be treated in strictest confidence) will be received until February 14, 2020 or until the post is filled.
